Duration	This Schedule will commence as soon as the Commonwealth and Western Australian Government sign it and will expire on 31 December 2024 or on completion of the projects, including final performance reports, unless terminated earlier or extended as agreed in writing by the Parties.
Purpose	This Schedule will support the delivery of the Regional Recovery Partnership in the South-West of Western Australia region. This Partnership supports existing state and regional recovery plans with a package of targeted initiatives to deliver jobs, economic recovery and economic diversification.
Partnership	The projects under the Partnerships are:
project	 Food Organics, Garden Organics (FOGO) Compost Facility
purposes	Construction of a new organics composting facility that enables the Bunbury Harvey Regional Council to upscale its established composting operation and increase production volumes of its Australian Standard organic product with the capacity to supply a range of uses.
	- Nannup Cycle Trail Network
	Transform the town of Nannup into a trail town to attract visitors, trail users and businesses through the investment of trail infrastructure including mountain bike trails, a freestyle jump park, traffic bridge, toilets, directional signage and car parking.
	- Manjimup Trail Bike Hub
	Position Manjimup as the centre for trail bike riding in Western Australia, creating a significant new catalyst for visitation to the Shire, the region and the State. The Hub will include new trail development, craft new tourism experiences, create marketing activities to raise awareness and enhance supporting infrastructure such as accommodation, restaurants, cafes and specialty shops that cater for trail bike riders.

Estimated financial contributions

The Commonwealth will provide a total financial contribution to the Region of \$10 million in respect of this Schedule.

Western Australia will provide in-kind support throughout the Partnership and local government will provide \$3.63 million. These contributions are reflected in Table 1.

On commencement of the Schedule \$3.84 million will be paid, and upon commencement of the amended Schedule, \$6.16 million will be paid.

Tables 2 (a), (b) and (c) summarise the milestones for the projects, their relationships to the outputs, expected completion dates and expected payments to be made.

The Western Australian Government will provide performance reporting in accordance with Table 2 during the operation of the Schedule. Each performance report is to contain tracking of actual performance in the period to date against project milestones across all projects and advice on any broader policy issues impacting on Partnership delivery. The reports, as appropriate, should also explain how projects have contributed to Partnership objectives in particular strengthening economic diversification and resilience, and how its impact has been amplified by other efforts.

Evaluation

The Commonwealth will be responsible for conducting an evaluation of the Partnership and initiatives delivered under this Schedule within 12 months of its expiry.

Western Australia and other project proponents will be responsible for participating in the evaluation.

Western Australia is to provide information to contribute to the evaluation, including a summary of initiatives implemented under the Partnership and the outcomes they have and are expected to achieve, and a statement on the completion of all capital works for these projects.

Shared roles

All Parties will continue to broker solutions between their different governments to help align efforts to assist economic recovery in the different regions.

All parties will commit to best practice governance arrangements in order to deliver the reports and Partnerships in a timely manner.

In addition, Schedule E, Clause 26 of the IGA FFR outcomes will be applicable to projects funded under Partnerships.
