Variations to Annual Business Plans that directly affect milestones and payments are subject to written agreement between the relevant Commonwealth and Western Australian minister.

Western Australia will be responsible for ensuring:

- 1. That the advisory committees use and provide the expert scientific, technical and community advice available.
- 2. Effective consultation and engagement with First Nations people with rights and interests in the World Heritage areas.
- 3. The World Heritage areas are managed in a manner consistent with the EPBC Act.
