

Addendum to Schedule E5 (SA) to the National Housing and Homelessness Agreement (NHHA)

2022-23	\$4.9m


29. The annual statement of assurance produced for clause 36 of the NHHA will include the information set out in the table on the following page.

Definitions:

1. Refurbishment is defined as any works undertaken on a dwelling to improve its amenity
2. SOMIH – State Owned and Managed Indigenous Housing
3. Major maintenance is defined as public housing and SOMIH dwellings requiring maintenance at capital value of > \$10,000
4. New emergency and crisis accommodation delivered refers to initiative outcomes managed and/or funded by the South Australian Government
5. Households in receipt of state rental subsidies refers to current active bonds provided to households through the South Australian Government’s Private Rental Assistance Program
