

BILATERAL SCHEDULE BETWEEN THE AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY AND THE COMMONWEALTH ON SKILLS FLEXIBLE FUNDING

PRELIMINARIES

1. This bilateral schedule (Schedule) is between the Commonwealth of Australia (Commonwealth) and the Australian Capital Territory (the Parties) under the 2024-2028 National Skills Agreement (Agreement) and should be read in conjunction with the Agreement.
2. This Schedule sets out bilateral arrangements pursuant to Part 5 of the Agreement (Funding Arrangements).

TERMS

3. The terms of this Schedule are set out in Clauses A15-16 of the Agreement.
4. This Schedule will expire on 31 December 2028.

FLEXIBLE FUNDING ARRANGEMENTS

5. Table 1 details the Australian Capital Territory's estimated Flexible Funding as follows:
 - (a) the estimated minimum financial contribution (representing the Australian Capital Territory's projected entitlement under the National Skills and Workforce Development Specific Purpose Payment),
 - (b) the estimated maximum financial contribution to Cap 1, and
 - (c) the estimated maximum financial contribution to Cap 2.

MAINTENANCE OF EFFORT BENCHMARK

6. For the purposes of Clause A50(c) of the Agreement, the Commonwealth will determine that the Australian Capital Territory has met the maintenance of effort benchmark where its Eligible State Expenditure for the relevant financial year meets or exceeds the amounts in Table 2:
